



## STUDENT MEALS

Bonneville School District 93 Child Nutrition offers daily breakfast and lunch to all students. Free and reduced priced meals are available to those who qualify.

### Free and reduced priced meals

All parents are encouraged to fill out a free and reduced application either in paper form or online at [horizon.d93.k12.id.us](http://horizon.d93.k12.id.us). A new form is required every school year.

### Menus

Menus are available online on the District website. The menu is subject to change due to availability of product.

### Meal Accounts

Bonneville School District 93 Child Nutrition uses a debit account cafeteria system. Every student is expected to prepay for his/her meal account or have cash/check at the time of purchase. Parents should prepay BEFORE students run out of money. Online deposits can be made onto the student's account through MyPaymentsPlus. The website can be accessed through our District website or at <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com>.

Any remaining meal balances at end of the school year, will be carried over to the next school year.

Students leaving the District should request a refund. At the end of each school year, all inactive student balances will be transferred first to sibling accounts, if available, and then to the Child Nutrition donation account.

Students at the elementary and middle school level are allowed two charges and high school students are not allowed to charge (Board Policy #8415). After two charges, students will be given an alternate meal. When a student's account balance reaches negative \$.01, a phone call and email will be made notifying parents of the negative balance. Parents can pay for a student's account balance in the cafeteria or online at <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com>.

### Special dietary needs

In an effort to accommodate children with special dietary needs, a signed medical statement is required. If the special dietary condition creates a disability a *physician's* signature is required. For non-disabled participants, a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or registered nurse must sign the form. Please fill out the Special Dietary Needs form and return it to the Food Service Department.
